BY THE CHAIRMAN: On October 3, 2017, Blue Ridge Electric Membership Corporation (BREMC) and Charter Communications Properties, LLC (Charter) filed a joint motion seeking entry of a stipulated modification of the procedural schedule in this docket. The Parties represented that, on June 7, 2017, the Commission entered an Order Establishing Procedural Schedule, establishing among other things, certain deadlines for the Parties to propound discovery and to submit pre-filed direct, responsive, and rebuttal testimony in this matter, which the Commission amended in the Order Granting Leave to Amend Verified Petition and Denying Motion for Temporary Stay entered on September 27, 2017. Further, the Parties represented that they mutually agreed to modify the aforementioned procedural schedule as follows:

1. Extend the deadline for BREMC to pre-file direct testimony from October 11, 2017 to October 16, 2017;
2. Extend the deadline for Charter to pre-file responsive testimony from October 27, 2017 to October 30, 2017; and
3. Extend the deadline for BREMC to pre-file rebuttal testimony from November 1, 2017 to November 6, 2017.

Finally, the Parties represented that the proposed modification of the procedural schedule will not delay or otherwise require rescheduling of the evidentiary hearing in this matter, which is currently scheduled to begin on November 8, 2017.


After careful consideration, the Chairman concludes that good cause exists to grant the motion.
