Mr. Bundy:

This letter will acknowledge receipt and review of your application for a certificate of exemption to transport household goods filed with the Commission on December 20, 2022. The protest deadline for your application is January 4, 2023.

Please be advised that you cannot lawfully operate as a mover of household goods within North Carolina until your application is approved by the Commission and you have purchased the proper for-hire license plates for your vehicle(s) from the Division of Motor Vehicles. Furthermore, until such time as you have been granted a certificate of exemption by the Commission, it is unlawful for you to orally, in writing, in print, or by sign, including the use of a vehicle placard, phone book, Internet, magazine, newspaper, billboard, or business card, or in any other manner, directly or by implication, represent yourself as holding a certificate or being otherwise authorized to operate as a household goods mover in North Carolina.
