8 Q. What is the purpose of your testimony?

9 Α. The purpose of our testimony is to provide support for the Settlement 10 Agreement and Stipulation (Stipulation) filed on March 21, 2024, 11 entered into between Red Bird Utility Operating Company, LLC (Red 12 Bird) and the Public Staff (together, the Stipulating Parties) regarding 13 the transfer of the seven water and six wastewater systems of A&D 14 Water Service, Inc. (A&D) and the public utility franchise serving the 15 following eleven service areas in Ashe, Henderson, Buncombe, 16 Transylvania, and Gaston Counties: Buffalo Meadows, Camelot, 17 Cinnamon Woods, High Vista, Hunters Glen, Kirk Glen, Mountain 18 Valley, Rolling Oaks Estates, Sherwood Forest, Skyview Park and 19 White Oak Village, requested jointly by A&D in Docket No. W-1049, 20 Sub 25 and by Red Bird in Docket W-1328, Sub 2 (Joint Application).

Q. Briefly describe the Stipulation.

A. The Stipulation sets forth the agreement between the Stipulating Parties on all items, including the Stipulating Parties' agreement that the transfer of the A&D's utility systems to Red Bird should be approved and that Red Bird will adopt the tariffs and rates currently in effect for the customers of each of the acquired systems.

The Stipulation provides that Red Bird will receive an acquisition adjustment in the amount of \$15,159 to be included in rate base due to the condition of the High Vista wastewater system, and associated compliance issues rendering it operationally troubled. Depreciation starts at the date of closing of transactions with an amortization rate of 4%.

The Stipulation also provides that the appropriate total net book value of the assets Red Bird is acquiring from A&D is \$19,046 as detailed by system in Public Staff Sun Exhibit 1, Schedule 1-1. No plant additions through the closing date will be included in this or any future proceedings. The net book value is based on plant additions through December 31, 2023, as provided by the Company, and includes depreciation calculated through December 31, 2023. No further plant additions through December 31, 2023 will be included in this or any future proceedings.

Regarding costs associated with the transfer, the Stipulation provides that, in its next general rate case, Red Bird may request recovery of costs for engineering due diligence work performed by 21 Design Group, Kimley-Horn and Associates, TRC Environmental Corporation, and Battelle Memorial Institute, listed in Red Bird witness Cox Direct Exhibit 6 up to \$159,121.50, provided that the work results in reasonable and prudent capital investments to improve the water and wastewater systems. The Stipulation also provides that Red Bird may request recovery of up to \$14,128.85 for legal costs related to the acquisition in its next general rate case.

To determine the portion of the agreed upon recovery of costs associated with the transfer assigned to each system required allocating the amount from each allowed Cox Direct Exhibit 6 invoice to each system. While most of the invoices from the Engineering firms showed the applicable A&D system, the legal invoices were not system specific and only referred to A&D. As a result, the Public Staff determined the percentage of the Engineering firm allowed invoiced amount assigned to each system, and then applied those percentages to the allowed legal and remaining engineering invoiced amounts of \$14,128.85 and \$19,634.22 to determine the total allowed cost of transfer expenses for each system. These results are shown in the following table.

Red Bird agrees not to pursue rate recovery of any remaining costs associated with the transfer, including due diligence, transactional, and regulatory costs, other than those listed above and as further detailed in Public Staff Settlement Exhibit 1. The amounts of \$159,121.50 and \$14,128.85 for engineering due diligence and legal costs, respectively, were determined based on Cox Direct Exhibit 6 and invoices provided in response to Public Staff Data Request 9.

- Public Staff Settlement Exhibit 1 provides a breakdown of these costs, including by invoice.

 Pursuant to the Stipulation, Red Bird agrees to adopt at closing
- A&D's accounting records, provide the detailed accounting records received from A&D to the Public Staff, and refrain from adjusting or making changes to those records without Commission approval.

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- If the Stipulation is approved by the Commission, beginning one year after the effective date of the order approving the Stipulation, and continuing annually, Red Bird and key leadership from CSWR, LLC, will meet with the Public Staff and provide an update detailing all changes in Red Bird's facilities and operations since the last annual update and discuss the Company's financial condition.
- Finally, pursuant to the Stipulation, Red Bird agrees to post a \$100,000 bond for the A&D utility systems.

15 Q. What benefits does the Stipulation provide for ratepayers?

A. Red Bird's agreement not to seek an acquisition adjustment beyond that provided in the Stipulation for High Vista, and the limitations on the amount of due diligence and legal costs Red Bird can recover, will minimize the magnitude of future rate increases. In addition, the conditions attached to Red Bird's recovery of engineering due diligence costs will help ensure that those costs are related to system

- improvements that help to maintain or improve service quality and reliability in all the acquired systems, especially on the High Vista wastewater system. Annual meetings between Red Bird and the Public Staff will keep the Public Staff apprised of changes to the systems and Red Bird's financial condition, and maintain open dialogue between the parties.
- Based on the foregoing, we recommend that the Commission approve the Stipulation.
- 9 Q. Does this conclude your testimony?
- 10 A. Yes, it does.
