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Duke Energy Progress, LLC ("DEP") and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC") (collectively "Duke Energy" or the "Companies"), pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-155(f), the North Carolina Utilities Commission's ("NCUC" or the "Commission") April 3, 2018 *Order Modifying And Approving Riders Implementing Solar Rebate Program*, and the Commission's September 20, 2018 *Order Modifying First Year of Solar Rebate Program* hereby notify the Commission that the 2020 annual participation caps for residential and non-residential customers under the Duke Energy Solar Rebate Program for both DEC and DEP have been met. Due to customer interest in Duke Energy's Solar Rebate Program, the 2020 annual participation levels for certain groups of customers were reached quickly after the Companies launched the 2020 application window on January 2, 2020. The participation limit for 2020 has not been reached, however, for the DEP and DEC non-profit customers.


**NOTIFICATION OF ANNUAL PARTICIPATION LIMITS BEING REACHED**

As directed by the Commission in its September 20, 2018 Order, Duke Energy hereby notifies the Commission that the annual participation limits for residential and non-residential customers have been reached for both DEC and DEP, and the Companies'

websites have been updated accordingly. A screenshot of the websites informing the public of the rebate limits being reached is attached as Appendix A.

Applications for residential and non-residential customers will continue to be placed on DEC and DEP waitlists in the event previously accepted applications are rejected. The Companies are continuing to accept applications for DEP and DEC non-profit customers, and the Companies will, in accordance with the Commission's September 20, 2018 Order, notify the Commission and update their websites when the annual participation limit for non-profit customers is reached.
