BY THE CHAIR: On April 30, 2014, the Commission issued an Order granting Fresh Air Energy XI, LLC (Applicant), a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) for the construction of a 5-MW solar generating facility to be located at 4331 Tick Bite Road in Grifton, Lenoir County, North Carolina. In addition, the Commission accepted registration of the facility as a new renewable energy facility.

On April 16, 2020, Applicant filed a statement requesting that Applicant be allowed to withdraw the application for a CPCN and registration, and requesting that this docket be closed.


