ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION
OF TIME FOR FILING BRIEFS
AND PROPOSED ORDERS

BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On September 12, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Excusing Witnesses, Canceling Expert Witness Hearing, Requiring Late Filed Exhibit, and Taking Notice of Prior Testimony in the above-captioned docket. The Order, among other things, set October 14, 2022, as the date for parties to file their briefs and proposed orders.

On October 10, 2022, Duke Energy Progress, LLC and the Public Staff (collectively Movants), filed a joint motion requesting that the date for filing briefs and proposed orders be extended to October 28, 2022. In support of their motion, Movants stated that they have been working diligently to prepare a joint proposed order but, due to the press of other matters, they need additional time to complete their joint proposed order. Further, Movants stated that they shared their motion with the other parties to this docket prior to filing it, and no party indicated that it objected to the requested extension of time.

The Presiding Commissioner, having considered Movants' motion and the representations therein, grants the motion for good cause shown and hereby extends to October 28, 2022, the date for all parties to file briefs and proposed orders.
