ORDER REQUIRING FILING  
OF EVIDENTIARY AND OTHER  
PROCEDURAL MOTIONS

BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONERS: On July 9, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Accepting Recommended Consolidated Issues for Remote Expert Witness Hearing and Postponing Separate Issue Hearings (Consolidated Hearing Order), in the above-captioned dockets involving the rate case applications of Duke Energy

Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP). The Consolidated Hearing Order identified the topics to be addressed by expert witness testimony in the consolidated DEC/DEP hearing to be held remotely beginning on July 27, 2020, and postponed the previously scheduled separate hearings on DEC's and DEP's applications.

In preparation for the consolidated and separate hearings, and pursuant to Commission Rule R1-7, the Presiding Commissioners find good cause to direct that on or before July 20, 2020, the parties shall file motions in limine, motions to strike, and all other evidentiary or procedural motions related to the consolidated or separate hearings. In addition, all such motions shall be accompanied by a short (not to exceed five pages) legal memorandum that includes all factual and legal bases for the motion.
