PURSUANT TO North Carolina Utilities Commission (Commission) Rule R1-7, the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, Sierra Club, and Natural Resources Defense Council (collectively, SACE et al.) respectfully move the Commission for a two-day extension of the deadline for parties to file presentation materials for the June 17, 2024 technical conference in the above-captioned docket, thereby extending the filing deadline from June 10, 2024 until June 12, 2024. SACE et al. provide the following information in support of their motion:

1. On January 17, 2024, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Public Hearings, Establishing Interventions and Testimony Due Dates and Discovery Guidelines, Requiring Public Notice, and Providing Direction Regarding Duke's Supplemental Modeling (Initial Procedural Order). The Initial Procedural Order required that a technical conference on intervenor testimony be held starting at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, June 17, 2024, and directed "[t]hat parties shall file with the Commission a list of individuals who will appear at the technical conference, as well as any presentation materials on or before Monday, June 10, 2024." Initial Procedural Order, Ordering Paragraph 6. On April 9, 2024, the Commission issued an Order Rescheduling Technical Conference for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, June 17, 2024.

- 2. SACE et al. are diligently preparing for the technical conference and are prepared to file, by Monday June 10, 2024, a list of the individuals who will appear at the technical conference on our behalf. Due to the press of business, however, we require additional time to finish preparing presentation materials. We respectfully request an extension of two days for all parties to file presentation materials with the Commission.
  - 3. The requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party.
- 4. Counsel for SACE et al. contacted all parties to this docket about the requested extension. Duke, the Public Staff, and no other intervening party has objected to the requested extension as of the filing of this motion.

WHEREFORE, SACE et al. request that the Commission issue an order granting a two-day extension of time, through and including Wednesday, June 12, 2024, for the parties to file presentation materials for the technical conference and any other relief the Commission deems reasonable and appropriate.
