) ORDER ACCEPTING) REGISTRATION OF NEW) RENEWABLE ENERGY FACILITY

BY THE CHAIRMAN: On March 27, 2015, as amended June 8, 2015, Innovative Solar 35, LLC (Innovative), filed a registration statement pursuant to Commission Rule R8-66 for a new renewable energy facility to be located in Albertson in Duplin County, North Carolina. Innovative stated that 1.98-MW<sub>AC</sub> solar photovoltaic (PV) facility will become operational on December 1, 2015.

The filing included certified attestations that: 1) the facility will be in substantial compliance with all federal and state laws, regulations, and rules for the protection of the environment and conservation of natural resources; 2) the facility will be operated as a new renewable energy facility; 3) Innovative will not remarket or otherwise resell any renewable energy certificates (RECs) sold to an electric power supplier to comply with G.S. 62-133.8; and 4) Innovative will consent to the auditing of its books and records by the Public Staff insofar as those records relate to transactions with North Carolina electric power suppliers.

On October 29, 2015, the Public Staff filed the recommendation required by Commission Rule R8-66(e) stating that Innovative's registration statement as a new renewable energy facility should be considered to be complete. No other party made a filing with respect to these issues.

Based upon the foregoing and the entire record in this proceeding, the Chairman finds good cause to accept registration of Innovative's PV facility as a new renewable energy facility. Innovative shall annually file the information required by Commission Rule R8-66 on or before April 1 of each year. Innovative will be required to participate in the NC-RETS REC tracking system (<u>www.ncrets.org</u>) in order to facilitate the issuance of RECs.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the registration by Innovative for its PV facility located in Albertson in Duplin County, North Carolina as a new renewable energy facility shall be, and is hereby, accepted.

2. That Innovative shall annually file the information required by Commission Rule R8-66 on or before April 1 of each year.
