NOW COME Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC") and Duke Energy Progress, LLC ("DEP", and together with DEC, "Duke Energy" or the "Companies"), by and through counsel and pursuant to Rule R1-7 and move the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") to extend the deadline to file Reply Comments as required by the Commission's May 12, 2023, Order Granting Extension issued in the above-captioned dockets. Specifically, the Companies request that the Commission extend the June 15, 2023 deadline to file reply comments by eight days to June 23, 2023.

In support of this Motion, the Companies show the Commission the following:

- 1. On January 27, 2023, the Companies filed their Joint Petition for Approval of Green Source Advantage Choice Program in the above-captioned dockets ("Petition for Approval of GSA Choice").
- 2. On February 9, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Requesting Comments and directed that "on or before March 28, 2023, the Public Staff and Intervenors may file initial comments regarding Duke's proposed GSA Choice Program; and [t]hat on

or before April 11, 2023, all parties may file reply comments regarding Duke's proposed GSA Choice Program."<sup>1</sup>

- 3. On March 24, 2023, the Public Staff-North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Public Staff") filed a Motion for Extension of Time to file initial comments.
- 4. In its March 28, 2023 Order Granting Extension, the Commission granted the Public Staff's Motion for Extension of Time and ordered the Parties to file initial comments on the Companies' Petition for Approval of GSA Choice on or before April 25, 2023 and reply comments on or before May 16, 2023.
- 5. As of the date of this filing, the Public Staff, North Carolina Attorney General's Office, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association ("NCSEA"), the Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates II ("CIGFUR II"), the Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates III ("CIGFUR III" and, together with CIGFUR II, "CIGFUR"), the Carolina Utility Customers Association, the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, the Clean Energy Buyers Association, Google LLC, the Carolinas Clean Energy Business Association, and the United States Department of Defense and all other Federal Executive Agencies have intervened (collectively, the "Intervenors") in the above-captioned dockets and filed their initial comments on April 25, 2023.
- 6. On May 3, 2023, the Companies filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Reply Comments. The Commission granted the Companies' Motion on May 12, 2023, extending the deadline to file reply comments to June 15, 2023.
- 7. The Companies continue to work diligently to review and respond to the Intervenors' initial comments. The Companies are requesting this additional time to

continue discussions with some Intervenors to better understand their positions in Initial Comments as well as due to the press of other business.

- 8. The Companies therefore request an additional eight days for all parties to file reply comments in these dockets, up to and including June 23, 2023.
- 9. The Companies have conferred with counsel for the Intervenors and all parties either support or do not object to the motion.

WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission issue an order extending the deadline for the filing of reply comments to June 23, 2023.
