

## BEFORE THE NORTH CAROLINA UTILITIES COMMISSION



BY THE CHAIR: On May 31, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Granting Motion for Extension of Time in response to a motion by the Attorney General's Office filed in the above-captioned dockets. The Order granted all parties an extension to July 10, 2019, and August 7, 2019, to file comments and reply comments, respectively, regarding the demand-side management and energy efficiency (DSM/EE) mechanisms by which Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (collectively, Duke) recover their DSM/EE costs and incentives.

On August 5, 2019, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the date for reply comments be extended to September 6, 2019. The Public Staff stated that initial comments on Duke's DSM/EE mechanisms were filed by several intervenors, and that it would be helpful for the intervenors to meet and discuss their positions. The Public Staff stated that the meeting could reveal areas of consensus or potential avenues for the resolution of issues. Further, the Public Staff stated that it contacted all the intervenors about its proposed extension of time to file reply comments, and that they all indicated their willingness to participate in a meeting and their assent to the proposed extension of time.

Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend to September 6, 2019, the date for parties to file reply comments on Duke's DSM/EE mechanisms.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
