

Applicable to each bag, or any other item-charge item for large to travel larger than 49 cubic inches, but not exceeding 62 linear inches (including handles) and weighing less than 50 lbs. The charge is in addition to the base fare for the route and is subject to change without notice.

b. Excess \$12.00

Applicable to each checked item greater than the allowance as set forth below. This charge is in addition to the base fare for transporting the item, and additional charges will be assessed for excess weight, size, or number of items. The charge is in addition to the base fare for transporting the item.

Every day throughout the year the allowance is three (3) checked bags per passenger.

Items not included as baggage must be suitable for transport on board by a single passenger and must not interfere with the comfort and safety of other passengers, or the operation of the transportation unit. Passengers may not carry-on checked items as set forth above.
