# A. TRANSPORTATION

P1. DOCKET NO. A-41, SUB 20 - APPLICATION OF BALD HEAD ISLAND TRANSPORTATION, INC., FOR AMENDMENT TO TARIFF LANGUAGE REGARDING BAGGAGE

EXPLANATION: On December 22, 2021, Bald Head Island Transportation, Inc. (BHIT) filed an application requesting approval of changes in its tariff regarding Item No. 40-D Class IX – Baggage to revise oversized baggage specifications, to reduce the standard allowance of checked baggage from six (6) to three (3) items per passenger, and to increase the excess baggage fee from \$5 to \$23.

BHIT states that the changes are intended to reduce ambiguity for ferry personnel, relieve excessive strain on service equipment, provide clearer guidance to passengers, and improve on-time performance and service quality. BHIT indicates that it has consulted with representatives of major stakeholders that use BHIT's system regarding the proposed changes. BHIT has filed letters supporting its proposal from ten (10) such stakeholder organizations and businesses.

The Public Staff has not received any feedback opposing the proposed changes, and has received supporting feedback from one individual resident, representing an informal group of Bald Head Island property owners.

RECOMMENDATION (Rajeev/Creech): That the Commission issue the Public Staff's proposed order approving BHIT's proposed revisions to its tariff.

BY THE COMMISSION: On December 22, 2021, Bald Head Island Transportation, Inc. (BHIT) filed an application with the Commission requesting approval of changes in its tariff concerning the applicability of the Item No. 40-D Class IX oversize baggage fare and the applicability and magnitude of the Item No. 40-D Class IX excess baggage fare.

Also on December 22, 2021, BHIT filed letters of support for the changes from Riverside Adventure Company, Always Ready Cars, Cary Cart Company, Bald Head Island Vacations, Tiffany's Beach Properties, Intracoastal Realty Corporation, The Inn at Bald Head Island, The Hammocks Association, Bald Head Association, and Village of Bald Head Island.

The current language for the Class IX - Baggage fare is:

### a. Oversized \$23.00

Applicable to each bicycle or any other non-carry-on item too large, heavy, or cumbersome to fit into baggage dollies, and to items longer than seven (7) feet. This charge is in addition to the fare for transporting the person.

b. Excess \$5.00

Applicable to each checked item greater than the allowance as set forth below. This charge is in addition to the fare for transporting the person. No allowance shall be permitted on tickets purchased for the sole purpose of avoiding payment of Excess charges.

Every day throughout the year the allowance is six (6) checked items per passenger.

Items not checked as baggage must be suitable for transport on board by a single passenger and must not interfere with the comfort and safety of other passengers, in the judgment of BHI Transportation staff. Passengers may not carry-on Oversized items as defined above.

BHIT's proposed language for the Class IX - Baggage fare is:

#### a. Oversized

\$23.00

Applicable to each bicycle, or any other non-carry-on item too large (~ coolers larger than 48-quart size), too heavy (i.e., more than 50 pounds), or too cumbersome (i.e., cannot fit into a baggage dolly), or to items longer than seven (7) feet. This charge is in addition to the fare for transporting the person.

b. Excess \$23.00

Applicable to each checked item greater than the allowance as set forth below. This charge is in addition to the fare for transporting the person. No allowance shall be permitted on tickets purchased for the sole purpose of avoiding payment of Excess charges.

Every day throughout the year the allowance is three (3) checked items per passenger.

Items not checked as baggage must be suitable for transport on board by a single passenger and must not interfere with the comfort and safety of other passengers, in the judgment of BHI Transportation staff. Passengers may not carry-on Oversized items as defined above.

BHIT stated that its proposed amendment to Class IX, section "a. Oversized" is intended to clarify the definition of "Excess Baggage" by adding size and weight limitations to the previously undefined terms of "large" and "heavy."

BHIT stated that its proposed amendment to Class IX, section "b. Excess Baggage" to reduce the number of allowed checked bags per customer and to increase the excess baggage fee is necessary due to physical capacity limitations of the dollies, personnel, ferries, and trams associated with the increase in passenger ridership, and due to the desire to maintain and improve on-time performance and the baggage handling service quality provided by BHIT.

BHIT stated that it proposes, at a minimum, to provide notice of the amended tariff by the same methods of notice and communications as ordered by the Commission in Docket A-41, Sub 9, specifically:

- "A. Providing an "alert" and/or scrolling banner notification of the new tariff provisions, with a link to the new provisions, on the websites <a href="https://baldheadlandferry.com/">https://baldheadlandferry.com/</a> and <a href="http://www.baldheadisland.com/island/ferry">https://www.baldheadisland.com/island/ferry</a> no later than 14 calendar days prior to their effective date.
- B. Posting a Notice to Customers about these tariff changes at both the Deep Point and Bald Head Island ferry terminals no later than 14 calendar days prior to their effective date.
- C. Publishing in a newspaper having general coverage in its service area a Notice to Customers about these tariff changes within 10 days of the date of the Commission's Order in this docket. The Notice to Customers shall cover no less than one-sixth of a page.
- D. Providing a copy the Commission's Order to the President of the Bald Head Island Club, the President of the Bald Head Association, the Mayor and Manager of the Village of Bald Head Island, and each of the stakeholders listed in paragraph 14 above no later than two business days after the date of the Order."

The Public Staff presented this matter at the Commission's Regular Staff Conference on February 21, 2022. The Public Staff indicated that there was no known opposition to BHIT's proposed tariff changes and recommended approval.

#### IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That, effective April 1, 2022, BHIT's Class IX-Baggage tariff shall be revised as shown in Appendix A to this Order. Within ten days after the date of this Order, BHIT shall file with the Commission a new supplement to its tariff (Supplement No. 12 to NCUC No. 7) that reflects the changes approved in this Order.

- 2. That, unless otherwise indicated below, BHIT shall, at its own expense and no later than two days after the date of this Order:
  - a. Provide an "alert" and scrolling banner notification of the new tariff provisions, with a link to this Order, on the websites <a href="https://baldheadislandferry.com/">https://baldheadislandferry.com/</a> and <a href="http://www.baldheadisland.com/island/ferry">https://www.baldheadisland.com/island/ferry</a>;
  - b. Post a copy of the Notice to Customers, attached hereto as Appendix B, at the Deep Point and Bald Head Island ferry terminals of Bald Head Island Transportation, Inc. located in Southport, North Carolina;
  - c. Publish the Notice to Customers in a newspaper having general coverage in its service area within 10 days of the date of the Commission's Order in this docket. The Notice to Customers shall cover no less than one-sixth of a page; and
  - d. Provide a copy the Commission's Order to the President of the Bald Head Island Club, the President of the Bald Head Association, and the Mayor and Manager of the Village of Bald Head Island, as well as to Riverside Adventure Company, Always Ready Cars, Cary Cart Company, Bald Head Island Vacations, Tiffany's Beach Properties, Intracoastal Realty Corporation, The Inn at Bald Head Island, and The Hammocks Association.
