ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE FOR THE ALL-SERVICES DISTRIBUTED OVERLAY OPTION IN THE 336 AREA CODE

BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On August 13, 2014, the Commission issued its Order Approving All-Services Distributed Overlay Option to Provide Area Code Relief (Relief Order). As part of that order, the Commission required that the schedule for implementation of the all-services distributed overlay in the 336 area code be filed with the Commission by the parties for informational purposes within 30 days of the date of the Relief Order. The current deadline for filing the implementation schedule is September 12, 2014.

On September 4, 2014, Neustar, Inc., in its role as the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), filed a Motion for Extension of Time for Filing Requirement in Order Approving All-Services Distributed Overlay Option to Provide Area Code Relief. On September 10, 2014, NANPA filed an Amended Motion for Extension of Time (Amended Motion).

In support of its Amended Motion, NANPA stated that to comply with the deadline, NANPA was required to schedule a meeting for industry members and provide the industry with two weeks' notice prior to the meeting, that NANPA issued the notice and the meeting was held on September 4, 2014 and that following the meeting, NANPA was required to publish the minutes of the meeting and to give the industry members time in which to review and offer changes to the minutes. Further, NANPA stated that the review period is typically seven days after which the minutes become final and seven days after September 4, 2014 is September 11, 2014, only one day before the filing deadline. NANPA also noted that without an extension of time, NANPA and the Industry would only have one day after the minutes have become final in which to produce the filing and that such a tight timeframe does not allow for any scheduling problems that might arise or provide any extra time for revisions or changes to the meeting minutes or to the filing itself. Additionally, NANPA observed that in order to ensure that there was enough time for the Industry to arrive at a consensus decision with regard to the relief implementation schedule and for Industry members to review and offer changes to the schedule and to the filing, NANPA needed a 30 day extension

to the filing requirement. Finally, NANPA noted that it had contacted each party listed on the service list and confirmed that none had any objection to the requested extension.

After carefully considering the Motion and the entire record, the Presiding Commissioner finds that good cause exists to extend the time to file the schedule for implementation of the all-services distributed overlay option in the 336 area code from September 12, 2014 until October 13, 2014.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
