BY THE CHAIR: On March 16, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Granting Extension of time for parties to file comments regarding issues on the generator inspection provisions of the North Carolina Generator Interconnection Standard. The Order allowed parties to file comments on the issues by March 29, 2021, and reply comments on or before April 12, 2021.

On April 7, 2021, Strata Solar, LLC and Strata Solar Development, LLC (together, Strata) and the Carolinas Clean Energy Business Association (CCEBA) filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file reply comments on the issues related to the generator inspection provisions of the North Carolina Generator Interconnection Standard. In the motion, Strata and CCEBA requested an additional 14 days to in order to have further discussion on the issues with Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (together, Duke), and the Public Staff. The motion further stated that Duke and the Public Staff did not object to the extension of time.

Based on the motion, the Chair finds good cause to grant the extension for parties to file reply comments generator inspection provisions of the North Carolina Generator Interconnection Standard. Parties may file reply comments on or before April 26, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
