BY THE CHAIR: On November 18, 2020, the Commission held an expert witness hearing in the above-captioned docket involving the application of Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct a 5-MW solar facility in Buncombe County, North Carolina. In a subsequent order, the Commission set January 11, 2021, as the date for parties to file briefs and proposed orders.

On January 11, 2021, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the Commission extend the due date for briefs and proposed orders to January 19, 2021. In summary, the Public Staff stated that it needs additional time due to time constraints associated with other cases. Further, the Public Staff stated that it had spoken with counsel for DEP, and that DEP does not object to the requested extension of time.

Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend the time for parties to file briefs and proposed orders to January 19, 2021.
