BY THE COMMISSION: On August 29, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Approving DSM/EE Rider and Requiring Filing of Proposed Customer Notice (DSM/EE Order), in the above-captioned docket approving revised DSM/EE rider rates to be implemented by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC). It has come to the Commission's attention that Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of the DSM/EE Order did not include reference to the supplemental testimony filed by DEC witness Carolyn Miller on April 28, 2023. The supplemental testimony included revisions to DEC's proposed DSM/EE rates that were ultimately agreed with by the Public Staff and approved by the Commission. See DSM/EE Order, at 22-23. However, Ordering Paragraph No. 1 inadvertently omitted reference to witness Miller's supplemental testimony.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Commission finds good cause to correct Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of the DSM/EE Order to state:


1. That the Commission hereby approves the calculation of Rider EE as filed by DEC in the direct testimony and exhibits of Company witness Miller, and revised in witness Miller's supplemental testimony and exhibits, to go into effect for the rate period January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024, subject to appropriate true-ups in future cost recovery proceedings consistent with the Sub 1032 Orders, the Sub 1130 Order, and other relevant orders of the Commission;

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
