NOW COMES THE PUBLIC STAFF – North Carolina Utilities Commission, by and through its Executive Director, Christopher J. Ayers, and moves that the public witness hearing previously scheduled on this matter be canceled. In support of this motion, the Public Staff respectfully shows unto the Commission:

1. This proceeding began with the filing of an Application for Rate Increase by C & P Enterprises, Inc. (C & P Enterprises) on August 27, 2021.
2. In an order issued on September 20, 2021, the Commission declared the proceeding to be a general rate case and suspended rates for up to 270 days.
3. By order dated November 16, 2021, the Commission scheduled a remote customer hearing at 7:00 p.m., on Wednesday, January 5, 2022.
4. In a certificate of service filed on November 19, 2021, C & P Enterprises indicated that all of its customers had been served with notice of the proposed rate increase and hearing.

5. The Public Staff did not receive any protests and no one registered to provide testimony at the public hearing by the deadline of December 29, 2021, as established in the customer notice.

6. The Public Staff requests that the public hearing scheduled for Wednesday, January 5, 2022 be cancelled.

7. A proposed order is being filed with this motion.

WHEREFORE, the Public Staff moves:

1. That the Commission grant the Public Staff's request to cancel the public hearing scheduled at 7 p.m., on Wednesday, January 5, 2022; and

2. For such other and further relief as the Commission may deem just and proper.

BY THE COMMISSION: This proceeding began with the filing of an application for rate increase by C & P Enterprises, Inc. (C & P Enterprises) on August 27, 2021. In an order issued on September 20, 2021, the Commission declared the proceeding to be a general rate case and suspended the proposed new rates for up to 270 days. By order dated November 16, 2021, the Commission scheduled a remote customer hearing at 7:00 p.m., on Wednesday, January 5, 2022.

On January 3, 2022, the Public Staff filed a Motion to Cancel Hearing. In its motion, the Public Staff stated that the Company had filed the requisite Certificate of Service, which attested that all customers received notice of the rate increase and the hearing, and that no customers submitted a complaint or registered to provide testimony at the hearing.

Based upon the foregoing, the Commission is of the opinion that the hearing scheduled for January 5, 2022, should be canceled.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the remote customer hearing previously scheduled for Wednesday, January 5, 2022, is canceled.
