BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On October 15, 2021, Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc. (PSNC), the Public Staff, Carolina Utility Customers Association, Inc., and Evergreen Packaging, LLC, filed a Stipulation of Settlement (Stipulation) in the above captioned proceeding. Paragraph 27 of the Stipulation states that within 15 business days of the filing of the Stipulation, PSNC and the Public Staff will file with the Commission a mechanism to (1) allow PSNC to recover all reasonable and prudent costs incurred for adopting, implementing, and operating cost-effective energy efficiency measures and programs and (2) establish certain requirements for requests by PSNC for approval and continued operation of energy efficiency programs consistent with the provisions for the piloting of PSNC's energy efficiency programs.

On October 29, 2021, PSNC filed a Motion for Extension of Time to file an agreed form of energy efficiency mechanism with the Commission as contemplated in Paragraph 27 of the Stipulation. In support of its motion, PSNC states that PSNC and the Public Staff have been diligently working on finalizing the energy efficiency mechanism but have not completed it.

Based on PSNC's motion and the record, the Presiding Commissioner hereby grants the motion to extend the date for filing the energy efficiency mechanism in compliance with Paragraph 27 of the Stipulation to Wednesday, November 10, 2021.
