BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On August 19, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Approving CPRE Program Cost Recovery Rider and Compliance Report. Ordering paragraph 1 erroneously states that “DEC’s request to establish a prospective rate component as described herein is approved and that this rider shall remain in effect for a 12-month period beginning on *September 1, 2021*, and expiring on *August 31, 2022*[.]” (Emphasis added.) Also, ordering paragraph 2 erroneously states that “DEC’s request to establish an EMF rate component as described herein is approved, subject to the disallowance of excess IA fees, and that this rider shall remain in effect for a 12-month period beginning on *September 1, 2021*, and expiring on *August 31, 2022*[.]” (Emphasis added.)

Therefore, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to correct ordering paragraphs 1 and 2 to read:

1. That DEC’s request to establish a prospective rate component as described herein is approved and that this rider shall remain in effect for a 12-month period beginning on September 1, 2022, and expiring on August 31, 2023;

2. That DEC’s request to establish an EMF rate component as described herein is approved, subject to the disallowance of excess IA fees, and that this rider shall remain in effect for a 12-month period beginning on September 1, 2022, and expiring on August 31, 2023.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
