2		Testimony (Order), the Commission directed DEC to answer specific
3		questions. This Order also directed the Public Staff to respond to the
4		additional information provided by DEC.
5	Q.	IS IT YOUR OPINION THAT DEC ANSWERED THE
6		COMMISSION'S QUESTIONS IN A COMPLETE AND
7		SATISFACTORY MANNER?
8	Α.	Yes, in his testimony, witness Bell answered the Commission's
9		questions listed in the Order:
10 11 12		1) Explain whether the Applicant has been restored to its original queue position, and the date on which it was restored;
13 14 15 16		2) Explain whether any new interconnection studies have been conducted for the Rockingham facility after 2016. If new studies have been conducted since 2016, file the new interconnection studies; and
17 18 19 20 21		3) Explain if DEC identified the Rockingham facility as triggering affected system upgrades in any neighboring system, including Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP). If DEC has identified the Rockingham facility as triggering affected system upgrades, please provide

- any associated Affected System Studies, or provide
 any information as to when any such Affected System
 Studies are expected to be completed.
- According to witness Bell, the Applicant was restored to its original queue position. However, the Applicant's interconnection request
- 27 has been suspended at the Applicant's request. No new studies have

- 1 been completed for this project since 2017. The project has not
- 2 triggered any affected system upgrades.¹
