NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on February 25, 2015, Meadowlark Solar, LLC (Applicant), filed an application seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) for construction of a 4.998-MW solar generating facility to be located on the west side of Meadowlark Road, northwest of the fork intersection with Fairground Road in Dunn, Harnett County, North Carolina. The Applicant plans to sell the electricity to Duke Energy Progress, Inc.

If no complaint is received within the time specified above and if the Commission does not order a hearing upon its own initiative, the Commission will enter an order awarding the certificate sought by the Applicant.
