NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on April 14, 2022, Duke Energy Progress, LLC ("DEP" or "Applicant") filed with the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") an application to obtain a certificate of environmental compatibility and public convenience and necessity to construct approximately 2.1 miles of new 230 kV transmission line in Wake County, North Carolina.

The route's western endpoint is a proposed tap of the middle point of the Harris Plant-Wake 230kV line. The route travels south-southeast from the tap location approximately 0.44 miles, then turning east-southeast for 0.80 miles and crossing White Oak Creek and its associated floodway to a point approximately 180 feet south of Utley Creek. The route then bears east for approximately 0.86 miles to the proposed substation location.
