BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On June 29, 2020, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order in the above-captioned docket that, among other things, set the deadline for the filing of direct testimony and exhibits (testimony), of intervenors and the Public Staff for August 25, 2020, and date for the filing of the rebuttal testimony of Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), if any, as on or before September 3, 2020.

On August 24, 2020, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the Commission extend to August 28, 2020, the date for the Public Staff and other intervenors to file direct testimony, and extend to September 8, 2020, the date for DEP to file rebuttal testimony.
