## NCUC DOCKET A-41, SUB 21

## **Stipulation Commitments**

- 1. The Parties (Bald Head Island Transportation, Inc. and Bald Head Island Limited, LLC and SharpVue Capital, LLC and its Affiliates) to the Asset Purchase Agreement ("APA") shall not buy or sell any of the unregulated parking or barge assets subject to that APA on or before November 18, 2022;
- 2. The Parties to the APA will provide to the Commission at least 10-days written notice filed in Docket No. A-41, Sub 21 prior to the closing date of any purchase or sale of any of the unregulated parking or barge assets subject to that APA prior to a final determination on the complaint in Docket No. A-41, Sub 21;
- 3. The Parties to the APA shall provide to the Commission at least 10-days written notice filed in Docket No. A-41, Sub 21 prior to the execution of any proposed waiver, modification, or amendment of any material terms of the APA, specifically including, but not limited to, any provisions contained in Articles 3, 5, 7, 8 or Schedule 7.5 of the APA;
- 4. The Parties to the APA shall file confidentially in Docket No. A-41, Sub 22 any tolling agreement executed by the Parties tolling or extending any date under the APA, including without limitation, the "Outside Date."
