

On March 10, 2010, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("Duke") filed a Motion for Clarification and Reconsideration of the Commission's February 9, 2010 Order Approving Agreement and Joint Stipulation of Settlement Subject to Certain Commission-Required Modifications and Decisions on Contested Issues in the above-referenced docket.
