BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On November 15, 2013, in the above captioned proceeding, the Commission issued a Notice of Due Date for Briefs and/or Proposed Orders, stating that the Notice of Transcript of Testimony in Docket No. E-100, SUB 136, was emailed from the Offices of the Commission on November 15, 2013; and pursuant to the ruling of Commissioner Brown-Bland made in open hearing on October 30, 2013, briefs and/or proposed orders are due to be filed with the Offices of the Commission by December 16, 2013.

On December 11, 2013, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association (NCSEA) filed a Motion for Four Day Extension of Filing Deadline with the Commission. NCSEA stated that due to staff illness it was requesting that the Commission grant an extension of the filing deadline for briefs and/or proposed orders from Monday, December 16, 2013, to Friday, December 20, 2013. NCSEA further stated that it had consulted with Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC; Duke Energy Progress, Inc.; Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a Dominion North Carolina Power; the Public Staff; the Renewable Energy Group; and the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy. NCSEA stated that each of these parties has indicated it had no objection to the extension. Finally, NCSEA stated that it had notified all remaining parties to this proceeding and none had raised an objection.

The Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to grant an extension of time to file briefs and/or proposed orders until Friday, December 20, 2013, for all parties to this proceeding.
