companies maintain numerous industrial manufacturing facilities and employ thousands of

workers throughout the State of North Carolina, including the territory in which Duke Energy

Progress ("Progress"), Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("Duke"), and Dominion North Carolina

Power ("NC Power") have been authorized by the Commission to sell electricity at retail.

4. CUCA's member companies use electricity in the operation of their
