ORDER ALLOWING COMMENTS ON 2019 ANNUAL REPORT

BY THE CHAIR: Pursuant to Part VIII of House Bill 589 (Session Law 2017-192) enacting N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-155(f), Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (collectively, Duke), jointly filed a proposed solar rebate program on January 22, 2018, which was approved by Commission order dated April 3, 2018. Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of that order, Duke is required to file an annual report on or before April 1 of each year including specific information about program participation and any proposed changes to the Solar Rebate Program.

On April 1, 2020, Duke filed its Solar Rebate Program Annual Report for calendar year 2019 and a request to amend program application windows for calendar years 2021 and 2022.

The Chair finds good cause to allow the parties to file comments on Duke's annual report.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That on or before June 5, 2020, the Public Staff and intervenors may file initial comments addressing Duke's Solar Rebate Program Annual Report, which was filed on April 1, 2020;

2. That on or before July 6, 2020, all parties may file reply comments responding to the initial comments filed by other parties; and

3. That, upon receipt of the parties' initial and reply comments, the Commission will proceed as appropriate in reviewing Duke's Solar Rebate Program Annual Report.
