BY THE CHAIR: On November 16, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Hearings and Requiring Customer Notice in the above-captioned docket that, among other things, scheduled a public witness hearing to be held via remote means on January 5, 2022, and set a deadline for registration to testify at the public witness hearing as no later than 5:00 p.m., on December 29, 2021. The public witness hearing was scheduled for the sole purpose of receiving testimony from C & P Enterprises, Inc.'s customers. The November 16, 2021 Order stated that the public witness hearing may be canceled if no significant protests are received from customers by the deadline stated in the customer notice.

On November 19, 2021, C & P Enterprises, Inc., filed its certificate of service indicating that all customers had been served with notice of the proposed rate increase and public witness hearing.

On January 3, 2022, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the public witness hearing scheduled for January 5, 2022, be canceled. In support of its motion, the Public Staff states that it did not receive any customer protests and no one registered to provide testimony at the public witness hearing by the deadline of December 29, 2021, as established in the customer notice.

Based upon the foregoing and the record, the Chair finds good cause to cancel the public witness hearing scheduled for Wednesday, January 5, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
