TotalEnergies hereby expresses its support for Public Staff’s *Motion Requesting Issuance of Commission Order* filed on April 17, 2024. Particularly, TotalEnergies supports any process that expedites action on the production and development of offshore wind, as it is imperative to address the “urgency inherent in meeting the emission reduction goals set forth in House Bill 951 . . . in a least-cost manner while ensuring a reliable grid.” [*Motion Requesting Issuance of Commission Order* filed April 17, 2024, p. 7, ln. 1-3.]

TotalEnergies looks forward to collaboratively working with the Commission, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP; collectively with DEC, the “Companies”) and other stakeholders during 2024 in pursuit of the development and adoption of a strategy to accelerate offshore wind development, decarbonize the Companies’ generation

resources, and maintain a diverse and reliable electric generation and fuel resource mix to serve the Carolinas.
