NOW COME Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC" or "Company") and the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Public Staff") and request that the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") issue an order excusing all witnesses from testifying at the May 30, 2023 Evidentiary Hearing in the above-captioned matter. In support of this motion, DEC and the Public Staff show the following:

- 1. On February 28, 2023, DEC pre-filed the testimony and exhibits of witnesses Kimberly A. Presson and Veronica I. Williams along with the 2022 Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard ("REPS") Compliance Report in this docket.
- 2. On March 16, 2023, the Commission issued its *Order Scheduling Hearing*, *Requiring Filing of Testimony, Establishing Discovery Guidelines, and Requiring Public Notice*, setting the date and time for an Evidentiary Hearing in this docket to begin on May 30, 2023, at the conclusion of the hearings scheduled in Docket No. E-7, Subs 1281 and 1282.

- 5. Counsel for DEC and the Public Staff have consulted with counsel for all parties to this docket, and all parties agree to waive cross-examination of the Company's and Public Staff's witnesses and do not object to the introduction of their testimony, exhibits, and affidavits into the record.

Accordingly, DEC and the Public Staff request that all witnesses be excused from appearing at the May 30, 2023 hearing in this docket and that the testimony, exhibits, and affidavits of the respective witnesses be received into the record.
