BY THE CHAIR: On June 6, 2023, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order in the above-captioned docket that, among other things, set July 24, 2023, as the date for the Public Staff and other intervenors to file direct testimony regarding the annual review of the gas costs of Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc. (PSNC).

On January 24, 2023, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the date for filing direct testimony be extended one day to July 25, 2023. In summary, the Public Staff stated that it is working diligently to prepare its direct testimony but needs additional time to review the supplemental testimony to be filed by PSNC today. In addition, the Public Staff stated that it contacted counsel for PSNC and that PSNC does not object to the requested extension of time.

Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend to July 25, 2023, the date for the Public Staff and all intervenors to file direct testimony.
