BY THE CHAIR: On September 16, 2020, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and Dominion Energy North Carolina (jointly, Utilities) filed a Storage Retrofit Stakeholder Meetings Report (Report) in compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 31 of the Commission's April 15, 2020 Order Establishing Standard Rates and Contract Terms for Qualifying Facilities and the Commission's August 31, 2020 Order Granting Extension of Time in the above-captioned docket.

In the April 15, 2020 Order, the Commission outlined the categories that the report should address and stated that the report shall identify the areas of consensus reached on these categories by the stakeholders and, in the areas where the stakeholders fail to reach consensus, the Utilities shall recommend a resolution. In their Report, the Utilities present a summary of the four stakeholder meetings that were held and the issues and proposed solutions for each of the categories outlined in the Commission's order.

While it appears that consensus was reached on a number of issues, there was not complete agreement on all issues. The Chair, therefore, finds good cause to allow parties to file initial and reply comments in response to the Utilities' Report.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That on or before November 20, 2020, any party may file initial comments in response to the Utilities' September 16, 2020 Storage Retrofit Stakeholder Meetings Report, and may file reply comments on or before December 11, 2020, responding to the initial comments filed by other parties; and
- 2. That the Commission will proceed as appropriate upon receipt of the parties' comments.
