BY THE CHAIRMAN: On November 2, 2018, the Commission issued an order in the above-captioned dockets granting the Public Staff's motion for an extension of time to November 14, 2018, to file a recommendation regarding the effects of the Federal Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (Tax Act) corporate income tax decrease on Dominion Energy North Carolina (DENC's) State Tax Rider EDIT.

On November 14, 2018, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting a second extension of time to November 20, 2018. The Public Staff states that DENC and the Public Staff have continued to discuss DENC's proposal, but additional time is needed to resolve a few outstanding questions. Further, the Public Staff states that DENC and Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates have no objection to a second extension of time.
