BY THE COMMISSION: On June 17, 2015, the Commission issued an order granting a certificate of public convenience and necessity for Aulander Holloman Solar, LLC, (Applicant) for construction of an 80-MW<sub>AC</sub> solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located east of NC Highway 42/Highway 11 near the intersection of Joe Holloman Road and Brickmill Road, near Aulander, in Hertford and Bertie Counties, North Carolina.

On March 27, 2018, the Applicant filed an amendment to its application stating that the facility's site location has been modified by removing one parcel of land and adding other parcels of land located south and north of NC Highway 42 and east of Indian Spring Road. The amendment included an updated site map showing that the facility will be located entirely within Hertford County. In addition, the Applicant stated that the facility has been assigned the following E911 addresses: 208 Joe Holloman Road and 146 B West Brickmill Road, Aulander, North Carolina.

On March 28, 2018, the Commission issued an Amended Order Requiring Publication of Notice.

On May 3, 2018, the Applicant filed a verified certificate of service stating that the application and the related public notice were provided to Dominion Energy North Carolina on April 3, 2018.

Also on May 3, 2018, the Applicant filed an affidavit of publication from The Roanoke-Chowan News Herald (Ahoskie, North Carolina) stating that the publication of notice was completed on April 28, 2018. No complaints have been received.

On May 4 and 11, 2018, and again on June 7, 2018, the State Clearinghouse filed comments. Because of the nature of the comments, the cover letter for the comments filed June 7, 2018, indicated that no further State Clearinghouse review action by the Commission was required for compliance with the North Carolina Environmental Policy Act.

The Public Staff presented this matter to the Commission at its Regular Staff Conference on June 18, 2018. The Public Staff stated that it had reviewed the amendment and determined it to be in compliance with the requirements of G.S. 62-110.1(a) and Commission Rule R8-64. Therefore, the Public Staff recommended approval of the amended certificate for the facility.

After careful consideration, the Commission finds good cause to approve the amended application and issue the requested amended certificate for the proposed solar photovoltaic electric generating facility.

### IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the application filed by Aulander Holloman Solar, LLC, for an amended certificate of public convenience and necessity shall be, and is hereby, approved.
- 2. That Appendix A shall constitute the amended certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to Aulander Holloman Solar, LLC, for the 80-MW<sub>AC</sub> solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at 208 Joe Holloman Road, 146 B West Brickmill Road, and south and north of NC Highway 42 and east of Indian Spring Road, Aulander, Hertford County, North Carolina.
