NOW COMES Aqua North Carolina, Inc. ("Aqua" or "Company"), by and through its undersigned counsel, and clarifies its Notice of Intent to Place Temporary Rates in Effect Subject to an Undertaking to Refund Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-135 and Request for Approval of Notice and Undertaking filed on January 26, 2023 ("Notice of Intent").

1. The Notice of Intent states in part:

By the temporary rates to be implemented subject to an Undertaking to Refund, the Company will increase its current rates and charges for its Aqua Water Rate Division by \$4,208,356, which represents a 9.9%, temporary rate increase; Aqua Sewer Rate Division by \$1,767,004, which represents a 9.5%, temporary rate increase; Brookwood Water Rate Division by \$723,966, which represents an 11.1% temporary rate increase; Fairways Water Rate Division \$144,239, which represents a 10.9%, temporary rate increase; and, Fairways Sewer Rate Division by \$254,832, which represents a 11.3%, temporary rate increases.

(Emphasis added.)

- 2. N.C.G.S. § 62-135(b) requires that "No rate or rates placed in effect pursuant to this section shall result in an increase of more than twenty percent (20%) on any single rate classification of the public utility.
- 3. Aqua's rate classifications are the five rate divisions listed in numbered paragraph 1 above. As represented in that paragraph, the revenue increase under temporary rates will be less than 20% for each of Aqua's rate classifications. Thus Aqua's Notice of Intent complies with the statutory limit of no more than a 20% increase. The statute characterizes the 20% limit as applying to each rate classification as a whole, not separate components of the rates (such as the volumetric component of a rate).
- 4. The temporary rate for customers within the Aqua Sewer Rate Division who have metered usage will include a volumetric (or usage) component that is greater than 20%. However, the revenue increase for that Rate Division will not be greater than 20% under temporary rates.
- 5. In addition, although the statute does not apply the 20% limit to individual bills, the combined basic facility charge and volumetric charge for customers in the Aqua Sewer Rate Division will result in monthly bill increases under 20% for customers within a normal range of usage. Only customers with an exceptionally high usage rate could experience an increase greater than 20%. This is illustrated in the calculations below:

The Aqua Sewer Rate Division residential customers who have metered usage average 4,380 gallons per month. At that usage level, the monthly bill would increase 13.8% under the temporary rates. Residential customers with metered usage in the other sewer rate classification, the Fairways Sewer Rate Division, will have only a 13% increase in their volumetric rate. In sum, the proposed temporary rates will result in less than a 20% revenue increase for each Aqua rate classification, and less than a 20% increase in the average bill for each category of customer.

- 6. Aqua has explained its position on compliance with the 20% statutory limit to the Public Staff but has not received a response at this time.
- 7. The Company provides this Clarification to explain that the Notice of Intent does meet the requirements of N.C.G.S. § 62-135.
