BY THE CHAIR: On September 20, 2022, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (Duke), jointly filed a Motion to Compel Avangrid Renewable, LLC's (Avangrid) Response to Data Request and Request for Expedited Treatment (Motion), requesting that the Commission enter an order compelling Avangrid to respond in full to Data Request No. 1-7.

Subsequent to the Motion, on September 20, 2022, Avangrid provided its second supplemental response to Data Request No. 1-7.

On September 23, 2022, Duke filed a motion to withdraw its Motion. Duke states that after reviewing Avangrid's second supplemental response to Data Request No. 1-7, it believes that Avangrid has adequately responded to its requests. Therefore, Duke requests to withdraw its motion to compel. Duke states that Avangrid does not oppose the motion to withdraw.


Based upon the foregoing and the entire record herein, the Chair is of the opinion that good cause exists to grant the request and allow Duke to withdraw the motion to compel.
