Pursuant to the North Carolina Utilities Commission's (the "Commission") May 28, 2021 Order Requesting Comments on Proposed Permanent Rate Designs, Extending Pilot Rate Designs and Adding Parties, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC" or the "Company") provides the following reply comments in response to the comments filed on June 15, 2021 by the Public Staff of the North Carolina Utilities Commission (the "Public Staff") and on June 30, 2021 jointly by the North Carolina Justice Center, North Carolina Housing Coalition, Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, and Natural Resources Defense Council ("NC Justice Center et al.") concerning DEC's May 7, 2021 petition for approval of three dynamic rate designs.

The Public Staff and NC Justice Center *et al*. filed comments supporting approval of DEC's proposed dynamic rate designs as filed. No parties filed comments opposing approval.

DEC agrees with the Public Staff's comments regarding the meaningful beneficial shifts in energy consumption and behavior that can be achieved through the proposed rates, as well as the increasing value of load reductions through rate design as the Company's

system shifts to a winter peaking system. Additionally, as noted by the Public Staff, approval of the proposed rates should not infringe on the work of the Comprehensive Rate Design Study, as ordered by the Commission's March 31, 2021 Order Accepting Stipulations, Granting Partial Rate Increase, and Requiring Customer Notice, which could potentially result in further refinement and/or expansion of DEC's portfolio of rate schedules.

In their comments, NC Justice Center et al. asked DEC to take steps to make the proposed rates accessible to low-income households and to work with stakeholders to provide additional rate offerings to incent EV charging at off-peak times. DEC supports these goals and intends to work with stakeholders through the Low-Income Affordability Collaborative and Comprehensive Rate Design Study to identify and evaluate potential solutions.

WHEREFORE, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission take these reply comments into account and approve the three dynamic rate designs as requested in the Company's May 7, 2021 Petition for Approval of Three Dynamic Rate Designs.
