ORDER CANCELING PUBLIC
HEARINGS

BY THE CHAIR: On February 23, 2021, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), filed its applications for approval of its Renewable Energy & Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard cost recovery and 2020 REPS compliance report pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-133.8 and

Commission Rule R8-67, for approval of its competitive procurement of renewable energy program cost recovery rider pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-110.8, for approval of DSM/EE cost recovery pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-133.9 and Rule R8-69, and for approval of its annual fuel charge adjustment pursuant to N.C. Gen Stat. § 62-133.2.

On March 18, 2021, the Commission issued orders in the above-captioned dockets which required the Applicant to publish a Public Notice of public hearings to be held on these matters starting at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 1, 2021. The Public Notice was attached to each respective order and, in part, stated that only individuals registered with the Public Staff by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, May 24, 2021, would be allowed to testify at the hearings for the purpose of receiving public witness testimony.

On May 27, 2021, DEC filed a motion to cancel the hearings scheduled for the purpose of receiving public witness testimony in the in the above-captioned dockets. The motion stated no members of the public registered to speak at the hearings. The motion further stated that the Public Staff supports DEC's motion.

Based on the motion and the record as a whole, the Chair find good cause to cancel the hearings scheduled for the purpose of receiving public witness testimony in the in the above-captioned dockets.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
