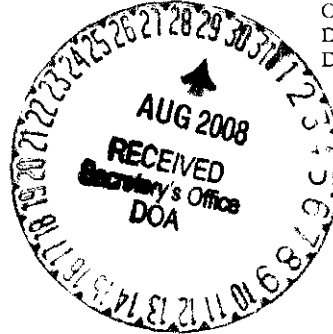

SUBJECT: Install photovoltaic generation facilities on large buildings owned by customers, Duke Energy Carolinas, Multi County, CH 08-1764



We have received notification from the State Clearinghouse concerning the above project.

We will need to review any project in which the solar photovoltaic structure is mounted on a structure 50 years or older or is located on a National Register structure or within a National Register Historic District and is visible from the public right-of-way.

There are no known archaeological sites within the proposed project area. Based on our knowledge of the area, it is unlikely that any archaeological resources that may be eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places will be affected by the project. We, therefore, recommend that no archaeological investigation be conducted in connection with this project.

The above comments are made pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's Regulations for Compliance with Section 106 codified at 36 CFR Part 800.
