BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On March 1, 2019, Aqua North Carolina, Inc. (Aqua or the Company), through counsel, filed a Motion for Extension of Time (Motion) in the above-captioned proceeding. In the Motion, Aqua informs the Commission, among other things, that it was directed to work with the Public Staff to file its Tenth Semi-Annual Report Regarding Secondary Water Quality Concerns (Report) on March 1, 2019. According to Aqua, the Company and the Public Staff have been diligently working to finish the Report. However, areas of significant disagreement between the two parties exist which require additional time to resolve before a Report can be filed, thereby necessitating a request for an extension of time. Aqua seeks an extension of time until March 11, 2019, to file the Report. Aqua further informs the Commission that the Public Staff does not oppose the Motion. Finally, Aqua informs the Commission that the Attorney General and Intervenor Eric Galamb, the other parties to Docket No. W-218, Sub 497, were contacted by electronic mail about the Motion and asked if they oppose it. No opposition from the parties has been recorded or filed.

The Presiding Commissioner has reviewed the record, including Aqua's Motion, and is of the opinion that good cause exists to grant the extension of time in this matter.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That Aqua shall have an extension of time from March 1, 2019, until March 11, 2019, to file its Report; and
2. That this Order shall be served on the parties of record by electronic mail, delivery confirmation requested.
