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NOW COME Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively, the "Companies"), pursuant to Rule R1-7(a)(5) of the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") and the *Order Requiring Filing of Supplemental Comments*, issued by the Commission on April 22, 2022, and subsequent orders granting motions for extension of time, respectfully move the Commission for a 60-day extension of time to December 6, 2022, for all parties to file supplemental reply comments. In support of their joint motion, the Companies show as follows:

1. On April 22, 2022, the Commission issued an order directing the Companies, DENC and the Public Staff to file comments on the implementation of, and any updates to, the utilities' respective customer billing and data management systems, and the utilities advanced metering infrastructure, explaining how these developments inform or affect the parties previously filed comments.
2. The Order also encouraged, without requiring, other intervenors to file supplemental comments on these and any other relevant developments since the filing of past comments.



3. On July 22, 2022, the Companies, the Public Staff, Dominion Energy North Carolina (“DENC”), the Attorney General’s Office (“AGO”), and Mission:Data filed Supplemental Comments. Some parties proposed revisions to previously drafted rules. Some revisions were substantial.
4. On August 4, 2022, the Companies filed for an extension of time to file supplemental reply comments on September 7, 2022. The Commission granted that extension of time.
5. On August 31, 2022, the AGO filed for an extension of time to file supplemental reply comments, stating that the AGO has met with other parties to see if agreement can be reached on the treatment of requests for disclosure of aggregated customer data and additional time is needed for further discussions. The Commission granted that extension of time, and the current deadline is October 7, 2022.
6. The parties are engaged in discussions, and additional time is needed for further discussions to find ways to achieve common ground on multifaceted policy questions, while concurrently handling other pressing matters.
7. The requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party.
8. Counsel for the Companies has contacted counsel for the parties to this docket about this requested extension, and no party objected to it.

WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission issue an order granting an extension of 60 days, up to and including December 6, 2022, for all parties to file supplemental reply comments.
