BY THE COMMISSION: On June 26, 2023, Pluris, LLC (Pluris or Applicant) filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to transfer Pluris' wastewater treatment plant and wastewater utility systems in Onslow County to the Onslow Water and Sewer Authority (ONWASA), which is exempt from Commission regulation.

Transfer of Pluris System customers to ONWASA would result in an increase in the average monthly residential wastewater bill from \$58.08 to \$59.96, based on 4,000 gallons of wastewater per month. Existing Pluris System customers would not be required to pay a connection fee to ONWASA.

Pluris' base charge for non-residential wastewater service is not based on the size of the serving meter. Most of Pluris' non-residential customers are served by meters 1" or less in size (153 meters out of 186). ONWASA's rates for non-residential wastewater service are based on meter size and would increase the average monthly wastewater bill if a customer is served by a meter larger than 3/4," with the extent of the increase dependent on the size of the serving meter.

The Pluris System is not troubled. It is an advanced state of the art membrane bioreactor treatment plant between four and ten years old. Since it has been in service, North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality has issued one Notice of Violation to Pluris for a limit exceedance violation that occurred on May 31, 2021. NOV-2021-LV-0596 was issued on August 11, 2021, when flow through the North Topsail wastewater treatment plant exceeded the specified monthly average amount. No other violations have been identified. ONWASA will continue using the present system. There is no replacement planned in the immediate future.

Pluris and ONWASA are entering into a contract under which ONWASA will accept ownership and operational control of the Pluris System.

The Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission (Public Staff) presented this matter at the Commission's Staff Conference on July 24, 2023. The Public Staff recommended that Pluris should be required to provide notice to all affected customers of the Application, including the applied for rates.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission is of the opinion that Pluris should be required to provide notice to all affected customers of the Application, including the applied for rates, and that the Commission may decide this matter without a public witness hearing if no significant protests are received as specified in this Order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

That the Notice to Customers, attached as Appendix A, be mailed with sufficient postage or hand delivered by the Applicant to all customers that may be affected by the proposed rates no later than 10 days after the date of this Order; and that the Applicant submit to the Commission the attached Certificate of Service properly signed and notarized not later than 15 days after the date of this Order.

EFFECT OF THE RATES:

Transfer of existing Pluris System customers to ONWASA would result in an increase in the average monthly residential wastewater bill from \$58.08 to \$59.96, based on 4,000 gallons of wastewater per month. Existing Pluris customers would not be required to pay a connection fee to ONWASA.

Pluris' base charge for non-residential wastewater service is not based on the size of the serving meter. The majority of Pluris' non-residential customers are served by meters 1" or less in size (153 meters out of 186). ONWASA's rates for non-residential wastewater service are based on meter size and would increase the average monthly wastewater bill if a customer is served by a meter larger than 3/4", with the extent of the increase dependent on the size of the serving meter.

The Commission may decide this matter without a public witness hearing if no significant protests are received from consumers within 30 days of the date of this notice. If a public witness hearing is held, it will be conducted in Onslow County. Transfer of Pluris Webb Creek System customers to ONWASA would result in a significant decrease in the average monthly wastewater bill from \$73.38 to \$59.96 for Pluris Webb Creek's residential customers, based on 4,000 gallons of wastewater per month. Existing Pluris Webb Creek customers will not be required to pay a connection fee to ONWASA.

Pluris Webb Creek and ONWASA's base charges for non-residential wastewater service are based on the size of the meter serving the customer. Most of Pluris Webb Creek's non-residential customers are served though meters 1" or less in size (6 meters out of 10). Pluris Webb Creek's non-residential customers served through a ¾" meter would see a reduction in their monthly wastewater bill from \$76.00 to \$59.96, assuming an average of 4,000 gallons of wastewater usage per month. EFFECT OF THE RATES:

Transfer of existing Pluris Webb Creek System customers to ONWASA's rates for residential wastewater service would result in a significant decrease in the average monthly wastewater bill from \$73.38 to \$59.96 for Pluris Webb Creek's residential

wastewater customers, based on 4,000 gallons of wastewater per month. Existing Pluris Webb Creek customers would not be required to pay a connection fee to ONWASA.

Pluris Webb Creek and ONWASA's base charges for non-residential wastewater service are based on the size of the meter serving the customer. The majority of Pluris Webb Creek's non-residential wastewater customers are served though meters 1" or less in size (6 meters out of 10). Pluris Webb Creek's non-residential customers served through a ¾" meter would see a reduction in their monthly wastewater bill from \$76.00 to \$59.96, assuming an average of 4,000 gallons of wastewater per month. Customers served by a meter larger than ¾" would see an increase in their monthly wastewater bill, with the extent of the increase dependent on the size of the serving meter.

PROCEDURE FOR PUBLIC HEARING:

At this point no public hearing has been scheduled. The Commission may decide this matter without a public hearing if no significant protests are received from consumers within 30 days of the date of this notice. If a public hearing is held, it will be conducted in Onslow County. Correspondence concerning the transfer or the need for a public hearing should be directed to the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission (Public Staff).

The Public Staff is authorized by statute to represent consumers in proceedings before the Commission. Written statements to the Public Staff should include any information that the writer wishes to be considered by the Public Staff in its investigation of the matter, and such statements should be addressed to Mr. Christopher J.
