PUBLIC STAFF'S SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION

NOW COMES THE PUBLIC STAFF - North Carolina Utilities Commission (Public Staff), by and through its Executive Director, Christopher J. Ayers, and moves that the Commission issue an order granting the Public Staff and KRJ, Inc., d/b/a KRJ Utilities Company (KRJ or Applicant) additional time to file testimony in the above-captioned docket. In support of this Motion, the Public Staff respectfully shows unto the Commission:

- 1. On January 10, 2018, the Applicant, filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to increase its rates for water utility service in Southern Trace Subdivision and water and sewer service in Rockbridge Subdivision in Wake County, North Carolina.
- 2. On February 6, 2018, the Commission declared the above-captioned docket a general rate case, suspended rates, scheduled hearing, and required customer notice.
- 3. The Commission Order specified that the Public Staff and intervenors should pre-file testimony on or before May 21, 2018, and also

provided that the Applicant should file any rebuttal testimony no later than June 4, 2018.

- 4. On May 18, 2018, the Public Staff file a Motion for extension of time to file testimony until May 25, 2018, which was granted by Commission Order on that same date.
- 5. The Public Staff and the Applicant are still engaged in settlement discussions and need additional time to complete those discussions.
  - 6. All parties consent to this Motion.

THEREFORE, the Public Staff requests that the Commission approve an extension of time to June 1, 2018 for the Public Staff and intervenors to file testimony. KRJ reserves the right to file a request for an extension of time for rebuttal testimony should the Public Staff and the Company be unable to execute a comprehensive settlement of all issues in dispute.
