MOTION TO WITHDRAW MOTION TO COMPEL AVANGRID RENEWABLES, LLC'S RESPONSE TO DATA REQUEST AND REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC") and Duke Energy Progress, LLC ("DEP") (collectively, the "Companies" or "Duke Energy") by and through counsel, hereby respectfully move the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") to withdraw the Companies' September 20, 2022 Motion to Compel Avangrid Renewables, LLC's ("Avangrid") Response to the Companies' Data Request No. 1-7 ("Motion to Compel"). In support of this motion, the Companies state the following:

1. On September 20, 2022, the Companies filed their Motion to Compel with the Commission, wherein the Companies requested that the Commission grant their Motion to Compel and enter an order compelling Avangrid to respond, in full, to Data Request No. 1-7 in the Companies' First Set of Data Requests to Avangrid. The Motion to Compel also requested that, in the alternative, the Commission strike Avangrid's Direct Testimony that appears at 11:17-20 when Avangrid moves for admission of that testimony into the record, or sooner through disposition of the Motion to Compel.

- 2. On September 20, 2022, Avangrid provided to the Companies its Second Supplemental Response to the Companies' Data Request No. 1-7. Avangrid's Second Supplemental Response included the reports requested in Data Request No. 1-7 and subject of the Motion to Compel.
- 3. Now, having reviewed Avangrid's Second Supplemental Response to the Companies' Data Request No. 1-7, the Companies believe that Avangrid has sufficiently responded to the request such that the Commission no longer needs to issue an order to compel, as provided by North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 37, or, in the alternative, strike Avangrid's Direct Testimony at 11:17-20. Accordingly, the Companies request to withdraw the Motion to Compel. Avangrid does not oppose the Companies' withdrawal of their Motion to Compel.

WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission grant the request to withdraw the Motion to Compel and grant such other relief that the Commission deems just and proper.
