BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On February 5, 2021, Thadeus B. Culley and James Calvin (Cal) Cunningham III (Movants), filed a joint Motion for Withdrawal and Substitution of Counsel for Vote Solar in the above-captioned docket, pursuant to Commission Rule R1-7 and Rule 1.16 of the North Carolina State Bar Rules of Professional Conduct. Movants requested that the Commission enter an order allowing Mr. Culley to withdraw from serving as the attorney of record on behalf of Vote Solar, and substituting Mr. Cunningham as counsel for Vote Solar. In summary, Movants stated that Mr. Culley will begin new employment on March 1, 2021, that the Motion was filed with the consent and at the direction of Vote Solar, that Mr. Cunningham is an attorney in good standing with the North Carolina State Bar, and that Mr. Cunningham consents to electronic service of documents pursuant to Commission Rule R1-39.


After careful consideration, the Presiding Commissioner finds that there is justifiable cause to grant the Motion.
