With this letter, Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina (“DENC” or the “Company”) advises the North Carolina Utilities Commission (“Commission”) that the Company is not filing rebuttal testimony in this proceeding.

On October 19, 2022, the Public Staff filed the testimony of Thomas C. Williamson, Jr., Utilities Engineer, Energy Division, and notice of affidavit and affidavit of Kuei Fen Sun, Financial Analyst III, Accounting Division, describing the Public Staff’s investigation of the Company’s August 9, 2022, request for cost recovery recommending that the Commission approve the Rider C and CE rates as proposed by the Company, subject to any true-ups in future cost recovery proceedings consistent with the 2022 Mechanism, N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-133.9, Commission Rule R8-69, and future Commission orders. Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates I (“CIGFUR I”), whose petition to intervene in this proceeding the Commission granted by order issued September 1, 2022, did not file any testimony.

In light of the Public Staff’s testimony and recommendations, and the fact that CIGFUR I did not file testimony, the Company is not filing rebuttal testimony in this proceeding.
