BY THE COMMISSION: On or about December 1, 2005, Robert K. Koger, President of the North Carolina Advanced Energy Corporation ("NCAEC"), filed a memorandum requesting approval to amend the Articles of Incorporation of NCAEC. The memorandum stated that "In order to better advance the corporate purposes of NCAEC, the Board recommends and respectfully requests that the Commission approve the amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of NCAEC. The Board of Directors of NCAEC recommended that the third sentence of Article 5, Section 1 of the Restated Articles of Incorporation is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety as follows.

"There shall be a maximum of fourteen (14) Directors of this Corporation. One Director shall be appointed by the North Carolina Utilities Commission and shall serve until such director's death, resignation, retirement, removal, or until a successor is appointed by the North Carolina Utilities Commission. The North Carolina Utilities Commission may remove this director at any time and in its sole discretion, either with or without cause, and appoint a successor. The remaining thirteen (13) directors shall be appointed in the manner hereinafter specified."

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Commission: (i) approves the above amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of NCAEC; and (ii) hereby appoints Robert K. Koger to serve as the director to be appointed by the Commission until his death, resignation, retirement, removal, or until a successor is appointed by the Commission in accordance with the Articles of Incorporation of NCAEC.
