



of interested third parties, and the Commission received several rounds of comments on a number of contested issues related to Duke's proposed NEM tariffs.

3. On November 8, 2022, the Commission issued an Order directing all parties to file proposed orders and briefs on or before December 2, 2022.

4. Due to the press of other ongoing dockets, the Public Staff requires additional time to prepare its comments on Duke's Application.

5. The Public Staff therefore requests that the Commission grant an extension to and including December 7, 2022, for all parties to file proposed orders and briefs.

6. The Public Staff has contacted all parties in this docket and none have opposed the motion.

WHEREFORE, the Public Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order extending the deadline for filing proposed orders and briefs to and including December 7, 2022.
